Although, vide order dated 14.07.2026, the parties were not directed to present in Court; however, they are present on their own.

Before we proceed to hear this habeas corpus petition on its merit, with the consent of the parties and their respective counsels, we propose the following arrangement:

- (1) The petitioner-mother is permitted to meet her children on daily basis in between 3 pm to 5 pm at the Mediation Center, Taluka Legal Services Authority, Bandikui on working days.
- (2) On holiday, the meeting may take place at any public place of the choice of the parties to be mutually agreed in between them.

(3) The respondents no.6 and 7-grandfather and grandmother of the children respectively, agree to take the children to the meeting place at scheduled time daily. They are directed not to cause any hindrance in meeting of the children with their mother as per aforesaid arrangement.

(4) The Secretary, District Legal Service Authority, Dausa is directed to make necessary arrangement at Mediation Center, Taluka Legal Service Authority Office for the meeting

(5) The aforesaid arrangement shall continue till the next date.

The Registrar (Judl.) is directed to intimate the officer concerned of this order today itself.
