Order

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners who had been appointed through a placement agency in the month of March 2025 are now sought to be replaced by

another set of contractual employees and fresh NIT dated 13.05.2026 (Annexure-4) has been issued for the said purpose. Counsel submits that it is a settled position of law that one set of contractual employees cannot be replaced by another.

2. In view of the submission made, Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also.

3. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.

4. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.

5. Notices be made returnable in six weeks.

6. Meanwhile, the services of the petitioner shall not be terminated.
