Order

1. On last occasion i.e. on 26.05.2026 when the matter was listed, this Court formulated the following legal issue:-

“Whether breach of agreement/contract amounts to an offence under Sections 420 & 406 IPC and whether the aggrieved person can file an F.I.R/complaint against such breach of contract/agreement or whether the legal recourse available to the aggrieved under such circumstances is to raise a civil dispute before the competent Civil Court”.

2. The Registrar (Judicial) was also directed to publish a note/notice in the daily cause list inviting the Members of Bar to address on the above issue.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the case is listed today and it is quite surprising on the part of the Members of the Bar that they are not interested to address the Court on the aforesaid

issue. No-one has put in appearance before the Court to address on the issue in question. Only two counsels Mr. Jai Lodha and Devanshu Gupta have put in appearance.

4. In the interest of justice and looking to the issue involved in the instant petition, this Court deems it just and proper to defer the matter to the next date. This Court hope, trust, expect and believe that the Members of the Bar would appear and address the issue on the next date.

5. List the matter on 03.08.2026 at 2:00 P.M.

6. Interim order, if any, to continue till then.

7. The Registrar (Judicial) is directed to once again publish the similar note/notice in the daily cause list and invite the Members of the Bar to address this Court on the aforesaid issue.
