Matter has come up on an application bearing Inward No.03/2024 filed on behalf of applicant under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. praying therein for grant permission to applicant to visit United Kingdom for a period of two months.

In the aforesaid application, it is pleaded on behalf of the applicant that during pendency of appeal, the applicant had filed an application for issuance of NOC for renewal of his passport to visit his ailing grand-daughter, who lives in Plymouth, England. Vide order dt.22.02.2024, the applicant was allowed to visit Plymouth England from 01.03.2024 to 30.04.2024. In compliance thereof, the Passport Authority has renewed the passport w.e.f. 21.03.2024. After renewal, the applicant applied for VISA from U.K. Embassy, which was issued to him for a period of 180-days w.e.f. 19.04.2024. Hence, it is prayed that

the permission may be granted to the applicant to visit United Kingdom for a period of two months.

Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the submissions made herein-above and prayed for dismissal of application.

For the reasons & grounds detailed out in the memo of application & considering the submissions made at bar, the application is **allowed**. The permission is, hereby, accorded to applicant, namely Data Ram Bhaskar son of Late Shri Udai Singh Bhaskar to visit United Kingdom from **19.04.2024 to 19.10.2024**. The applicant shall file an undertaking before this Court that he will return to India on or before **23.10.2024**.
