It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that by way of Annexure-1, the petitioner was given appointment on the post of Assistant Manager on 23.03.2013. Thereafter, on account of the overriding rules, the Registrar Co-operative Societies issued the order dated 23.08.2008 (Annexure-2).

Learned counsel further submitted that in light of Rule 26.6, as the petitioner had taken admission prior to 10.07.2017, the petitioner was eligible for consideration in the screening. It was

further submitted that several similarly placed individuals, as is reflected on Page 118, have been given appointment as well.

Learned counsel submitted that this Court, vide interim order, provisionally permitted for the screening of the petitioner.

Thereafter, when considering the petitioner for screening, it was observed by the respondents that the petitioner was ineligible in light of Rule 3, wherein the minimum age of consideration on the post of Assistant Manager was 21 years, whereas the maximum age was 33 years. Even if an additional 5 years was added, the same would come to 44 years in the Year 2013.

Accordingly, placing reliance upon the aspect of age and Annexure-3, learned counsel for the respondent submitted that the petitioner is not eligible.

Learned counsel for the State, Mr. Hari Barath, has submitted that on account of delay on the part of the officer in-charge, additional affidavit was filed today itself. Hence, the same could not be supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.
