1. The present writ petition has been filed aggrieved of the discontinuance of the petitioner from the post of Assistant (Peon) on contractual basis. Admittedly, there is no interim order operating in the matter and the discontinuance of the petitioner pertains to the year 2016.

2. It is also an admitted fact that the petitioner had been employed through a placement agency and some other employee having been transferred on the said post, no vacant post was available hence, as per the terms of the contract, the petitioner was removed.

3. Keeping into consideration the fact that the petitioner was a contractual employee who was discontinued way back in the year 2016, no relief can now be granted after a period of 10 years. However, a prayer for disbursal of the salary for the months of February and March 2016 has also been made in the petition.

5. The writ petition is hence **disposed of** with a direction to the respondent authorities to ensure that the salary qua the months of February & March 2016 is paid to the petitioner by the placement agency within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Stay petition and pending application, if any, stands **disposed of**.
