Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for a single cause of action, three repetitive FIRs are filed. It is further submitted that one of the FIR is made to be registered by the police authorities adopting a hand-in-glove approach with the complainant.

Further, learned counsel has submitted that one of the co-accused has already been enlarged on bail (Annexure-3).

Lastly, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that there are no criminal antecedents qua the petitioner. Moreover, in a civil matter, criminal color is given, not only by the complainant but by police authorities.

The Investigating Officer is directed to remain present in the Court, along with case diary qua the three FIRs.

List the matters on 12.09.2024.

In the meantime, no coercive/adverse action shall be taken against the petitioner.
