1. Application no. 1/2025 for vacation of stay order is dismissed as withdrawn.
2. Application stands disposed of.

During course of argument learned public prosecutor has submitted a report received from Additional DG, Crime Branch, Jaipur, Rajasthan wherein it has been submitted that a criminal case arising from FIR no. 144/2022 P.S. Ramnagariya, Jaipur (East) was investigated and after investigation the allegation made by the complainant were found as false. It has been further mentioned that further proceeding is under way.
