1. Considered application no.1/2025 and CMS no. 13224/2020.
2. Instant writ petition is preferred by the petitioner to quash and set aside the order dated 29.09.2020 issued by the respondent no.3 to discontinue the services of contractual employee and computer with machine after 31.08.2020.
2. A Co-ordinate Bench while considering the writ petition on 09.12.2020 has passed an interim order restraining the respondent(s) not to replace services of petitioner with another set of contractual employees with continuance of the petitioner and payment of due salary to the petitioner.
3. Now, an application is filed by the petitioner seeking direction to the respondent(s) for releasing salary of petitioner since 01.01.2023.
4. Learned counsel for respondent(s) submits that they have forwarded a proposal to the Finance Department and same is pending with Finance Department and it is not possible for the

Department to release the salary unless a specific sanction is issued by the Finance Department.

5. Having considered the fact that the petitioner is working as a contractual employee and a Co-ordinate Bench has protected him by interim order dated 09.12.2020 and same is in force till date. The admission also indicate that the petitioner is serving as contractual employee in the respondent department, therefore, application no.1/2025 is allowed the respondents are directed to make all due payment within a period of 30 days from date of receipt of copy of this order to the petitioner through a bank account and submit the compliance to this Court one week after expiry of 30 days as mentioned in the order.

6. Since, the issue requires consideration on merits, and interim order is in force since 09.12.2020, the petitioner has raised a triable issue, the interim order is made absolute till disposal of the writ petition.

7. Application no.1/2025 and CMS no. 13224/2020 stands disposed of.
