1. Matter has come up on misc. application (IA No.1/2025), wherein some arbitrary and unwarranted averments, in respect of apprehending death of petitioner and his family member, have been made by petitioner, which are uncalled for and have no basis at all. Virtually, by way of this application, petitioner has made a prayer for early hearing of the writ petition. This Court has already fixed the matter for 18.07.2025.

2. Petitioner, present in person, with folded hands prays withdrawal of this application with a prayer to extend early hearing of his writ petition.

3. In view of above, the misc. application (IA No.1/2025) is dismissed as withdrawn.

4. Let this writ petition be listed on 18th July 2025, as already fixed by this Court.

5. After passing the order, petitioner is unnecessarily interfering in the Court proceedings, while hearing other matters and despite

instructing for not interfering, he is continuously speaking. For such conduct of petitioner, it is desirable to saddle the petitioner with cost. This Court imposed cost of Rs.10,000/- on petitioner, but petitioner, with folded hands, requested to reduce the cost amount to Rs. 100/-.

6. Since cost is exemplary as to convey the petitioner not to interfere in the Court proceedings, more particularly after concluding of hearing of his case, hence this Court reduces cost amount to Rs.100/-.

7. In view of above, petitioner is directed to deposit cost of Rs.100/- with the Litigants Welfare Fund through Cheque/DD/ in Cash, in the name of Registrar General LWFA, Rajasthan High Court, on or before the next date of hearing i.e. 18.07.2025, which shall be precedent to pursue the writ petition, else the writ petition shall be dismissed for non-prosecution.
