Learned counsel for the applicant has relied upon umpteen number of judgments passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court wherein in spite of recovery of commercial quantity in certain circumstances, considering the special set of facts, *inter alia*, period of incarceration, delay in trial and exceptional nature of cases bail has been granted. Learned counsel has also relied upon certain Co-ordinate Bench judgments of this Court and upon standing orders issued by Administrative Authorities.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has relied upon judgment of **State of Kerala Etc. Vs. Rajesh Etc.** arising out of **SLP (Crl.) No.7309-7312 of 2019** wherein it is stated that rigors of Section 37 of NDPS Act once made applicable, the period of incarceration is immaterial as spelled out by larger Bench of Hon'ble Apex Court, therefore the judgments cited are not material.
