- 1 This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with following prayers-

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that Your Lordships may kindly pleased to call for the entire record of the case, examine the same and allow the writ petition by passing an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

"(i) Inaction of the respondents whereby the petitioner has been deprived to get the benefit of Selection Scale on completion of 9, 18 & 27 years of services may kindly be held as illegal, arbitrary and against the provisions of law and further the respondents be directed to grant the benefit of Selection Scale from the benefit of Selection Scale from the date of his entitlement and his pay be revised accordingly and the arrears be com-

puted and directed to pay all consequential benefits accrued thereof;

(ii) Any other order which this Hon'ble Court deems fit in the facts and circumstances of the case may also be passed in favor of the petitioner."

- 2 During course of arguments, learned counsel for petitioner while referring order dated **03.05.2023 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 6074/2023 titled as "Bhanwar Nath and Ors. Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation & Ors"** decided by a Co-ordinate Bench at Principal Seat, Jodhpur submits that the petitioners may be granted permission to file an appropriate representation before the respondents-Authority to consider and resolve his grievances in light to ratio decided on **25.01.2017 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 8810/2014 "Tara Chand Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation & Anr."**
- 3 Considered the grievance raised herein, the petitioner is given a liberty to submit a representation to the respondents-Authority within a period of 30 days raising all grounds and the respondents-Authority is directed to consider the representation in light of ratio as laid down in case of **Tara Chand Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation (supra)**, and relied in case of **Bhanwar Nath and Ors. Vs. Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation (supra)**.
- 4 In case of deviation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation with a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 30 days from date of receipt of representation. After passing the order, the respondents are under an obligation to communicate the decision to the

petitioner either by way of speed post or through E-mail, if
petitioner has provided E-mail in his representation.

With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition with
pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
