Issue notices to the respondents.

On directions of the Court, Mr. C.S. Sinha accepts notices for the respondent No.2 and Mr. Devesh Yadav accepts notices on behalf of learned ASG for respondent No.3.

Notices be served to the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply a copy of the petitions in the office of Mr. G.S. Gill, AAG and learned ASG.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the matters, this Court directs the petitioners to implead Enforcement Directorate-State Unit as a party in array of the respondents.

Amended cause title be filed.

List these matters on 10.09.2025 in the supplementary cause list along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.11999/2025.

Reply be filed by the next date of hearing.

The Liquidator concerned is directed to remain present in the Court via VC.

Upon perusal of the Court file, this Court has analyzed that approximately a sum of Rs.700 crores was taken as a deposit for different period by the petitioner/ cooperative, and the same was disbursed without following the due procedure, thereby siphoning the said amount. It is also analyzed that respondents have alleged that the loan amount was siphoned out, therefore, the liquidator has attached the property in question and motion of mutating and changes in the revenue records for furtherance of sale is taken/made.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the said act of the respondents is without jurisdiction and is violation to Article 89-90 of the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002.

Name of Mr. G.S. Gill, AAG, Mr. C.S. Sinha and Mr. Devesh Yadav be reflected in the cause list as counsel for the respondents.
