One application No.4532/2019 has been filed under Order 1 Rule 10 wherein it is contended that the applicant be impleaded in the matter as his father was running fair price shop in question, on account of death as per rules he was to be awarded compassionate allotment to the said shop. In this regard he has filed one SB CWP No.16365/2017 which is pending before the Hon'ble Court. In the present lis in question petitioner has also filed present writ petition with the prayer for allotment of fair price shop which has been allotted in favour of the respondent No.4.

Vide interim order dated 06.09.2018 this court has passed a qualified interim order whereby it was ordered that if the respondents are not allotted the shop in question and made the shop functional, the same would not be confirmed in favour of respondent No.4. It is submitted by learned counsel for

respondent No.4 that prior to passing of the said order the shop was functional. It is noted by the Hon'ble Court that against one single fair price shop there are three claimants one petitioner No.1, respondent No.4 and an impleader.

Registry is directed to tag SBCWP No.16365/2017 along with present writ petition as the same is interconnected matter.
