1. By way of filing the instant criminal misc. petition, a prayer has been made to quash the impugned FIR No. 316/2019, registered with the Police Station Kotwali, District Dausa for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 384, 467, 468, 471 and 102B IPC.
2. At the outset, learned Public Prosecutor on the basis of the factual report received from the Station House Officer, Police Station, Kotwali, District Dausa submits that after investigation, the Police has proposed the Final Report (Negative), hence, under these circumstances, no cause of action survives with the petitioner to continue with this petition and the same has become infructuous.

3. Considering the above factual aspect of the matter, the instant criminal misc. petition is dismissed as having become infructuous. Stay application as well as all pending application(s), if any, also stand dismissed.

4. However the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of this petition, in case, any cause of action/grievance still survives.

5. Factual report furnished by the Station House Officer, Police Station Kotwali, District Dausa is ordered to be retained on the record.
