Learned counsel for the petitioners have submitted that the petitioners are running a petrol-pump ever since 1955. It is further submitted that the landlord had died in the year 1970, thereafter, the petitioners deposited the rent before the concerned Court, as per the directions passed in the then suit.

It is further submitted that in the year 2023, petitioners have also filed a petition before the appropriate forum with a prayer to not dispossess them, wherein, the Court was pleased to pass an interim order, which is operational as on date.

Further, it is submitted that the property of the landlord is in dispute qua the issue of inheritance, will, sale deed and allied issues qua legal heirs.

Learned counsel has relied upon the provisions of clause 152 of the Ministry of Petroleum, Rules, 2001, wherein, situations are specified as to when to invoke suspension and cancellation of the license. It is further submitted that, in the said background, the respondents No.1 & 2 have issued a revocation letter, which is bad in law and the petitioners are facing a livelihood crunch.

Learned counsel for the respondents wants to study the matter and has sought time to seek instructions, qua cancellation of the license.

On the next date of hearing, the concerned Officer is directed to remain present in the Court along with relevant record to tender reasonable explanation.
