1. The matter comes up on applications (Inward Nos.01/2025 & 03/2025) filed by the Rajasthan High Court Lawyers' Association, Jodhpur and Rajasthan High Court Advocates Association, Jodhpur, respectively, praying for their impleadment as party respondents in the present case. Further applications (Inward Nos.02/2025 & 04/2025) have been filed on their respective behalf for recalling of the order dated 01.09.2025.
2. Vide order dated 01.09.2025, this Court observed as under:-

"The present case raises an important question of law as to whether the Bench has jurisdiction to hear the cases which arise from districts under the administrative jurisdiction of the Principal Seat, Jodhpur and similarly whether Principal Seat, Jodhpur can hear and pass the orders in relation to cases which arise from the

districts which are under the administrative jurisdiction of the Jaipur Bench”

3. Since notice was issued in the cause list at Principal Seat at Jodhpur as well as at the Jaipur Bench to all the lawyers to address on the important issue, the question of impleadment does not arise, as the respective Bar Association and Lawyers' Association can always address the Court apart from individual Lawyers so that due assistance may be granted as well. We also notice that it is a case where a writ petition was filed at Jaipur although the same should have been filed at Jodhpur.

4. Although, no one appears before us on behalf of Advocate Association as well as Lawyers Association. We have noticed the contents of the recall applications and find that the recall applications need to be addressed on merits by the concerned counsels.

5. In the interest of justice, list the case again on 25.02.2026 for arguments only.
