1. With the consent of both the parties, the present civil writ petition is disposed of in the following terms:

(i) The order dated 11.05.2018 is hereby quashed and set aside to the extent of closing the evidence of the defendant.

(ii) The learned Trial Court is directed to permit the petitioner-defendant to submit his three witnesses, as prayed by them.

(iii) The affidavits shall be filed on the same date, and cross-examination shall be conducted on the same date.

If the cross-examination is not completed due to paucity of time, another date may be fixed by the learned Trial Court for further cross-examination.

(iv) The petitioner shall be under the obligation to submit the affidavits and make his witnesses available for cross-examination by the plaintiff-respondent.

(v) The aforesaid exercise shall be carried out by the learned Trial Court within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 20,000/- to the plaintiff-respondent.

(vi) If the defendant fails to submit the affidavits, then this order will not come into effect.

2. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
