1. The present bail application has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS in connection with FIR No.296/2024, registered at Police Station Kundera, District Sawai Madhopur for the offence under Section 3/7 of the Essential Commodities Act.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant after arguing for sometime wants to withdraw the present bail application, making a limited prayer that the applicant be permitted to surrender before the concerned Trial Court, who may be directed to consider the plea of the applicant on the same date of surrender.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor has not objected the aforementioned plea.
4. Considering the foregoing facts and circumstances, and taking note of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the applicant; the fact that the FIR is of year 2024; that civil

proceedings are also ongoing and taking note of the fact that the investigation is moving at a snails pace; however without commenting anything upon the merits/demerits of the case, the present bail application is dismissed as withdrawn; with a direction that the accused-applicant shall surrender before the learned Trial Court concerned. The said Court is directed to consider the application so moved, or plea so made by the surrendering accused-applicant on the very same date.

5. Applicant is directed to render due cooperation in the ongoing investigation.
