It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that respondents have not complied with the impugned order passed by court in SB Civil Writ Petition No. 141/2020 dated 26.07.2023. It is argued that vide order dated 26.07.2023 respondents were directed to grant the petitioners pay scale of Rs. 6500-10500 on completion of 18 years of service. The court also directed the respondents to grant benefit to the present petitioners accordingly within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the order.

It is contended that the respondents in compliance to the order has not granted pensionary benefits to the petitioners and vide annexure-6, petitioners' service was computed as 32 years 3 months and 2 days. It is also contended that vide order in SB 16574/2024 the court gave specific direction with regard to addition of the pensionary service however, respondents have not added the service in accordance to the direction. It is also contended that the amount of Rs. 5,291/- (due against gratuity)

has also not been paid. It is also contended that Rs. 98,587/- as pensionary benefit, therefore the respondents may be directed to comply with the order passed in Writ Petition No. 141/2020.

Contrarily, it is contended by learned counsel for the respondents that pursuant to order passed in Writ Petition No. 141/2020 dated 26.07.2023 benefit of 18 years of service fixing the petitioner in the pay scale of 6500-10500 has been granted. It is also contended that petitioners filed another writ petition in which separate directions were passed with regard to correct computation of the pensionary service. The aforesaid order in writ petition No 141/2020 has already been comply with and no contempt is made out.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

Pursuant to the directions rendered in Writ Petition No. 141/2020, the petitioners have been granted benefit of pay scale of 6500-10500 and their revised pension order has been issued.

If the petitioner No. 6 is aggrieved with the non-compliance of order passed in writ petition No. 16754/2024 then petitioner is free to file a separate application.

The respondents are directed to verify the fact whether the amount of Rs. 5,291/- has been paid in petitioner number No. 6 account or not and furnish the relevant document.
