Contempt of the order dated 13.3.2018 passed in
SBCWP No.3998/2018 titled Rati Ram Sharma & Another vs. The
State of Rajasthan & Others, is alleged in this petition.

Reply to the contempt petition has been filed. It has been submitted that pursuant to the court's order dated 13.3.2018, the petitioners filed representation which was considered and it was decided to give the petitioners the pay-scales and revised pension in terms of the decision delivered by this Court in the case of Balram Verma vs. The Union of India & Others SBCWP No.18106/2012 decided on 18.11.2017.

Mr.Vijay Pathak counsel for the petitioners submitted that indeed the petitioners representations submitted pursuant to the Court's order dated 13.3.2018 have been decided to their benefit. He submitted that the petitioners are over 75 years of age and in the interest of justice, respondents may be required to make over the actual benefits pursuant to the orders dated 08.09.2019 passed by the District Education Officer (Headquarter), Karauli/ Sawai Madhopur within the reasonable time.

Dr.Ganesh Meena, AAG submitted that all attempts to will be made to pass over the actual benefits of the petitioners

pursuant to the order dated 8.9.2019 within a period of four months from today.

In view of the aforesaid, the contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly. Notices are discharged.

In the event actual benefits are not granted to the petitioners within four months from today, they shall be free to move an application for revival of this contempt petition.
