Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after remaining successful in all phases of the Sub-Inspector in Delhi Police, CAPFS and Assistant Sub-Inspector in CISF Examination, 2019, candidature of the petitioner has been rejected on account that he is suffering from Pityriasis Versicolor, a skin disease. Learned counsel submits that as per medical fitness certificate issued by the Rajkiya Jaipuria Hospital, Jaipur on 08.11.2021, he is medically fit and does not suffer from any skin disease. He submits that even otherwise also, as per guidelines for recruitment in Medical Examination in Central Armed Police Forces and Assam Rifles issued in the year 2015 by the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, this is not one of the criteria for rejecting candidature of a candidate.

Issue notice of the writ petition as well as of stay application. Rule is made returnable by five weeks. Notices be filed in two

sets. One set of notices be sent through registered post with acknowledgment due. Steps to be taken within a week.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner on interim relief.

Taking into consideration the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the material on record, this Court deems it just and proper to direct the respondents to keep a post vacant in pursuance of Examination, 2019, till further orders.
