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**HON'BLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE G R MOOLCHANDANI**

**JUDGMENT**

**14/05/2018**

1. Challenge in the above-captioned appeals is to a judgment dated 22.09.2015 disposing of a batch of writ petitions. The writ petitions have been disposed of issuing a direction to RPSC to prepare the select list strictly in conformity with the answer key provided by the first committee of experts. Noting that the revised merit list may repeat the names of those who had been appointed pursuant to the merit list prepared, it has been directed that for purposes of seniority their names would be arranged in the order of merit. Realising further that some candidates who were in the earlier merit list may be knocked out, it has been held that they would not be ousted from service if nothing adverse exists against them but they would be placed at the bottom of the revised list. Said direction is founded on the judgment of the Supreme Court reported as (2013) 4 SCC 690, Rajesh Kumar & Ors. Vs. State of Bihar & Ors.

2. Relevant facts to be noted are that RPSC issued an advertisement on 02.08.2013 inviting applications from eligible candidates to fill up vacant notified posts of School Lecturers in different disciplines. The paper of General Knowledge was common to all. Other papers being 17 in number were as per the discipline opted for by the applicants.

3. Thus, in all 18 question papers were set, out of which one was in General Knowledge and the remaining 17 under different disciplines such as Chemistry, Hindi, Geography, English, History, Physics etc.

4. Model answer key was uploaded on different dates between 21.10.2014 to 10.11.2014. First committee was constituted. Based on its report revised key was uploaded. The objectors persisted with their objection even to the report submitted by the experts and thus RPSC constituted a second committee of experts who considered the objections to the report of the first experts committee and based thereon RPSC uploaded the further revised answer key on various dates between 04.03.2015 to 27.03.2015 and based on the said revised (second) key prepared the select list and proceeded to issue letters offering appointment to the candidates. At that stage writ petitions came to be filed laying a challenge to the revised key, as notified pursuant to the recommendations of the second experts committee.

5. After hearing arguments of learned counsel for the parties the learned Single Judge has picked on four questions with respect to the reports of the second experts committee and has brought out the patent error in the answer key held to be correct by the second experts committee. The learned Single Judge has thereafter posed the question: How long would the process of appointing experts committees continue?

6. Though not expressly recorded by way of opinion in the impugned decision, the signature tune appears to be that humans not being 100% perfect it cannot be accepted that any work generated by human agency would be 100% accurate. Public interest demands that public posts should be filled up at the earliest and thus the direction issued is to prepare the select list as per the answer key opined to be correct by the first experts committee.

7. Such an attempt by a Division Bench of this Court in a batch of writ-appeals in the Division Bench judgment dated 08.03.2017 giving birth to Civil Appeal arising out of SLP(Civil) Nos.14306-14310/2017, Richal & Ors. Vs. Rajasthan Public Service Commission & Ors. has been opined by the Supreme Court not to be the correct approach in law. In the decision dated 03.05.2018 the Supreme Court reiterated the law declared by the Supreme Court in the decision reported as (1983) 4 SCC 309, Kanpur University Vs. Samir Gupta, which has been consistently followed by the Supreme Court in the decisions reported as (2005) 13 SCC 744, Manish Ujwal Vs. Maharishi Dayanand University & Ors., (2005) 13 SCC 749, Guru Nanak Dev University Vs. Saumil Garg & Ors., (2013) 4 SCC 690, Rajesh Kumar & Ors. Vs. State of Bihar & Ors. and held that the principle of law to be followed would be that the Court would start with a presumption that the model answer key is correct unless on the face of it it would be shown to be wrong. The inferential process of reasoning or by the process of rationalization to determine whether the model key is right or not has not to be followed. That is to say, the wrong must be so apparent that no reasonable body of man well versed in the particular subject would regard to be correct and that while carrying out the exercise text books which are commonly read by students have to be kept in mind.

8. It is with this understanding of law that we have, with the help of learned counsel for the parties, ventured into the process of analyzing the correctness of the model key, the key as changed by the first committee of experts and the key as corrected by the second committee of experts. Pertaining to 18 papers the questions involved are 144. We have, for purposes of

our judgment picked on the issue concerning General Knowledge and the paper of Geography and as we proceeded to analyze the same it dawned that it would be futile to carry out the same exercise pertaining to 16 other papers. The reason would be forthcoming as we proceed to note what emerged as a result of the analysis of the paper of General Knowledge and Geography.

9. Pertaining to the paper of General Knowledge, nine questions became the subject matter of the final dispute, though at the first instance we find objections being raised to as many as 63 out of 75 questions framed. Now, at the outset a figure of 63 objections to 75 questions is alarming by itself. Be that as it may, the report of the committee of experts which gave birth to the second model answer key (first being the original model answer key notified) upheld four objections pertaining to question Nos.43, 48, 50 and 59. The second committee upheld the objections to seven questions being question Nos.11, 43, 49, 63, 64, 70 and 75. Meaning thereby, of the four questions answer key whereof was recommended to be changed by the first committee the second committee accepted the correctness only qua two questions and added five more.

10. Thus, in this manner the number of questions which came to be the subject matter of debate between the parties becomes  $2+7= 9$ .

11. The nine questions would be as under:-

12. To question No.11 the model key gave option No.2 to be the correct option. The first experts committee held that the option was correct. The third committee opined that all options were incorrect for the reason Dadabhai Navroji was elected as the President of the Indian National Congress for the third time in the year 1906. It was the 21<sup>st</sup> year of the Congress and not the 20<sup>th</sup>. The question as noted was who acted as the President of the Indian National Congress thrice during its first twenty years. In other words option No.2 to the question treated as the correct answer by RPSC and first experts committee is demonstrably wrong and needs no process of argument to reach the conclusion. The report of the second committee correctly opines that the question has to be deleted for the reason all options were wrong.

13. Pertaining to the second question being No.43, the question concerns who won the ICC 20-20 Women's Cricket World Cup held in March-April, 2014 in Bangladesh. Indeed, it was the Australia. The model answer key listed option No.2 as correct. The first experts committee opined that the correct answer was option

No.4. The committee overlooked the fact that the question related to women and this was corrected by the second experts committee which brought back the answer as per the original revised key as the correct answer. Meaning thereby, the original key as published gave the correct answer. The first committee report was wrong. The second experts committee report is correct.

14. Question at S.No.3 being question No.48 gave option No.3 to be the correct option as per the model key. The first expert committee opined that option Nos.3 and 4 were both correct and thus suggested that the question be deleted. The second experts committee also recommended the question to be deleted but on a different reason.

15. As noted, the question was which of the following human diseases is controlled by the heredity. The model key gave the correct answer to be the Leukaemia and is supported by a text: HARRISON'S- Principles of Internal Medicine 18<sup>th</sup> Edition, at page 905.. As per the first experts committee even Leucorrhoea was controlled by heredity and thus, option Nos.3 and 4 were correct and therefore the question needed to be deleted. The second committee of experts opined all answers to be wrong giving the reason that Leukaemia is caused by chromosomal mismatch but is not inherited necessarily in the next generation.

16. Now, Leucorrhoea has many causes, one of them being estrogen imbalance. It is a vaginal discharge which could be caused even by an infection. It certainly has no concern with chromosome or genes and thus is not heredity.

17. The second experts committee recommends that Leukaemia is caused by chromosomal mismatch but merely on the

reasoning that it necessarily may not be inherited has opined the question to be deleted.

18. Now, the question is simple. The question is which of the following diseases is controlled by heredity i.e. related to the human genome or human chromosome. Indeed, the model answer is correct.

19. Fourth question being No.50 concerning thermal power plants and the three statements are followed by the question whether the statement-1 only, or 2 only, or 1 and 2, or 2 and 3 are correct.

20. The model answer key gave option No.1 i.e. first statement to be the correct answer. The two committees have unanimously held that option No.3 is the correct answer for the reason statement-1 and statement-2 are correct. Statement No.3 is incorrect because efficiency of thermal power plants ranges between 45% to 86%. The first and the second statement are indeed correct. Meaning thereby, for this question the answer provided in the model key is wrong and the answer provided by the first and the second experts committee is correct.

21. The fifth question being no.59 relates to three hybrid varieties grown in Rajasthan and the options are Maize, Gram, Wheat or Rice. The answer as per the model key is Maize. The first experts committee has opined that Megha was not a variety of Maize but was a variety of potatoes and rice. It has therefore directed the question to be deleted. The second experts committee has concurred with the model answer key. Indeed, material placed before us from the official website show that all three varieties mentioned in the question relate to Maize. Thus, the position would be that qua this question the answer in the

model key and the one by the second experts committee would be correct and the answer as per the first experts committee would be wrong.

22. The sixth question being No.63 concerns the theme of Yashpal Committee report, 1993. Option No.2 i.e. learning without burden has been unanimously opined by the original paper-setter and the first experts committee to be the correct answer. The second experts committee has held that the question was out of the syllabus.

23. The syllabus has been shown to us. Pertaining to educational management, educational scenario in Rajasthan and Right to Education Act, 2009 which guides the prospective candidates with the subject matter on which their knowledge would be tested, reads as under:-

*"Concept and functions of educational management, Educational management in Rajasthan, School as a unit of decentralized planning, Educational management information System (EMIS), Institutional planning, School mapping, Block Resource Centre (BRC), School Management Committee(SMC), District Information System for Education(DISE), Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan(SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan(RMSA).*

*Organisation of educational set up at primary and secondary in Rajasthan, Functions of RIE, SIERT, BSER, IASE, CTE, DIET, Rajasthan Educational Initiative, Balika Shiksha Foundation, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya, Rajasthan text book board, Bharat Scouts and Guides. Rashtriya Military school, Sainik school, Public school, Model school, E-Mitra, E-Governance, Rajshiksha, Edusat, Gyandarshan, Gyanvani.*

*Provisions of Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009."*

24. Indeed, as opined by the learned Single Judge, Yashpal Committee report related to the concept of educational management information system, institutional planning, school mapping etc. and thus we concur with the view taken by the learned Single Judge that the second option is the correct option and hold that without any process of reasoning the opinion of the second experts committee of the question being out of syllabus, is wrong. Pertaining to this question the position therefore would be that the answer provided in the model key concurred by the first experts committee would be correct and the answer treated as correct by the second experts committee would be wrong.

25. The seventh question being No.64 is as to which State first executed the concept of school complex. The model answer key provides the fourth option to be correct. It was accepted by the first experts committee. The second experts committee holds that the question was out of syllabus and thus needs to be deleted.

26. We have noted the relevant part of the syllabus hereinabove and we find that it embraces the concept of functions of school management and educational management in Rajasthan as a unit of decentralized planning, school mapping, educational management information system and thus it cannot be said that the question was outside the syllabus. Pertaining to this question, the position therefore would be that the answer provided in the model key and the first experts committee would be correct. The opinion of the second experts committee would be wrong.

27. The eighth question being No.70 relates to in the year 1986 and posits United Nations selected the Bharat Scouts and Guides as honorary in relation to which of the four options

provided. The model answer key concurred by the first experts committee is option No.2. The second experts committee has recommended deletion of the question on the reasoning that it is out of syllabus, overlooking the fact that the syllabus specifically includes Bharat Scouts and Guides as one of the topic. Thus, qua this question the model answer key and the key provided by the first expert committee would be correct and that by the second experts committee would be wrong.

28. The ninth question being No.75 tests the knowledge of the candidates pertaining to the Right to Education Act, 2009 and the question is which percentage is specified as minimum percentage of members from the parents or guardians of the children admitted in school to be represented in the school management committee. The answer provided in the model key is option No.2 which has been concurred by the first experts committee. The second experts committee has recommended deletion of the question on the reasoning that the school management committee includes parents of the children studying in the school while in the E.C. the percentage is 75%. Indeed, as reasoned by the learned Single Judge, under the Right to Education Act, 2009 the figure is 75% and thus, qua this question we find that the option as per the model key and by the first experts committee is correct and that by the second experts committee is wrong.

29. We put the data afore-noted in a tabular form. The option which would be wrong or correct has been noted by us in the table under the head 'Model Key, First Expert and Second Expert' which reads as under:-

30. We might not be very good at statistics but the data throws out a very interesting picture. Of the nine questions the model key is having seven correct answers with only two wrong answers. Report of the first experts committee has five correct answers and four wrong answers. The report of the second experts committee has four correct answers and five wrong answers.

31. Pertaining to the Geography paper, 13 questions became the subject matter of the final dispute, though at the first instance we find objections being raised to as many as 89 out of 150 questions framed. The figure of 89 objections pertaining to 150 questions is once again alarming by itself. Be that as it may, the report of the committee of experts which gave birth to the second model answer key (first being the original model answer key notified) upheld the objections pertaining to question Nos.34, 63, 122, 124 and 140 i.e. five questions. The second committee of experts upheld the objections to 8 questions, being Nos.36, 66, 70, 72, 97, 103, 104 and 109. Meaning thereby, there was no commonality to the objections to the various questions inter se

the two committees and in this manner the questions which came to be the subject matter of debate between learned counsel for the parties became 5+8= 13. The 13 questions would be as under:-

32. To question No.34, the model key gave option No.2 to be the correct answer. The first committee opined the same to be incorrect and gave opinion that the correct answer was option No.1, which learned counsel concede is the correct answer.. The second committee gave reason for option No.1 to be the correct on account of the reason that no material was placed before it by any objector concerning correctness of option No.1 and on said reasoning had upheld option No.1 to be the correct option.

33. Pertaining to question No.36, the model answer key gave option No.1 to be the correct option. The first committee of experts, with reference to text books held option No.1 to be the correct option. The second committee recommended deletion of the question reasoning that more than one option was correct. But the committee did not indicate which is the one more correct option. With reference to the text books on the subject, learned counsel concede that option No.1 treated as the correct answer in the model answer key and by the first committee would be the correct answer.

34. Pertaining to question No.63, the model key gave option No.1 as the correct answer. The first committee opined option No.3 to be the correct answer which was upheld by the second committee of experts on the reason that no objections were placed before it qua the report of the first experts committee. The question is: Which one of the following is not an

organic ocean deposit? The material placed i.e. the text books show that red clay is the correct answer. In other words, the model answer key was wrong and the opinion of the two expert committees is correct.

35. To question No.66 the model key lists option No.3 to be the right answer. This has been upheld by the first experts committee. The second experts committee has recommended deletion of the question on the reason that no book by the title concerned has been authored by any of the four authors listed. Indeed, the answer given by the second experts committee is correct for the reason M.Sorre authored the book "Les Fondements Biologiques de la geographie humaine". The position qua this question therefore would be that the answer provided in the model key and by the first experts committee is wrong and that by the second experts committee is correct.

36. Pertaining to question No.70, the model answer key gave option No.1 to be the correct option and the first committee agreed. The second committee recommended deletion of the question giving reason that the four options given were not in relation to the number of persons who had migrated and therefore the question was required to be deleted.

37. Now, the question does not pertain to the number of persons migrating. The question pertains to the factor causing migration from Myanmar to Bangladesh. As is known to all muslims migrated from Myanmar to Bangladesh and thus, the first option would be the correct option and therefore the model answer key and the opinion of the first committee is correct and that of the second committee is incorrect.

38. Pertaining to question No.97, the requirement would be of the four stretches of the National Highway being part of both East-West Corridor and Golden Quadrant. The model key lists NH-76 as the correct option and so does the first committee. The second committee has recommended deletion of the question opining that option No.1, option No.2 and option No.3 were correct. The data published by the NHAI shows that the correct answer is NH-76 and NH-14 and thus, the question would need to be deleted for the reason the correct options provided in the model key and by the first experts committee is wrong. Though the conclusion by the second committee is correct but it is on a wrong reasoning.

39. Pertaining to question No.103, the model answer key and the first committee concurred that option No.3 was the correct option. The second committee has recommend deletion on the reasoning that the question relates to agro-climate regions without clarifying which is the subject of the question

40. All learned counsel concede that the question is clear. It seeks information from the candidates as to what is the total number of agro-climate regions in Rajasthan and indeed, the material published by the Department of Agriculture, Government of India shows that Rajasthan has 10 agro-climate regions. Meaning thereby, the model answer key and the opinion of the first experts committee is correct and that of the second committee is wrong.

41. The next question No.104 is framed in the negative. The question is: Which is not an anthropogenic reason of desertification in Rajasthan? The model answer key lists option No.4 as the correct answer. The first committee accepted the

same. The second committee recommend deletion opining that all four options are the result of something done by human beings.

42. Now, anthropogenic means related to humans. The question has a connection between desertification and related to human. Surely, technological developments would only relate to human activities but would not have any concern with desertification and therefore learned counsel concede that option No.4 opined to be the correct option to the negatively framed question in the model answer key, upheld by the first committee of experts is correct and the opinion of the second committee is wrong.

43. Question No.109 is: Which of the following four districts of Rajasthan are having highest area in Rajasthan? The model key lists option No.2 to be the correct option which has been upheld by the first experts committee. The second experts committee has recommended deletion thereof for the reason the model answer key upheld by the first committee of experts did not read the word "forest" before the word "area" in the question and went by geographical area overlooking that the question pertained to the forest area and indeed, report shows that in different years forest areas in the districts of Rajasthan have varied and thus, unless the year in question was specified the question would be vague. Meaning thereby, the model answer key and the opinion of the first committee is wrong and that of the second committee is correct.

44. Pertaining to the next three questions when arguments advanced we wondered as to what would be the connection with the three questions in Geography but learned counsel conceded

that the questions would be related to Geography and thus, we proceed to analyse the same.

45. Question No.122 has been shown in the model key with option No.1 to be the correct answer. The first committee has referred to text books but opined that option No.2 is the correct answer. The second committee upheld the view taken by the first committee. Apart from the texts, common sense tells us that the bond relatable to theory of connectionism would be stimulus and responses and thus, the model key answer is wrong and that opined to be the correct by the first and the second committee of experts i.e. option No.2 is the correct answer.

46. The next question No.124, as per the model answer key has option No.4 to be the correct answer. The first and the second committee had opined option No.1 to be the correct answer. Indeed, learned counsel for the parties concede that pupils interaction alone does not result in committed teacher realising that the amount and quality of learning is determined to what considerable extent. Common sense tells us that content analysis and pupils interaction i.e. option No.1 is the correct answer. Meaning thereby, the model key is wrong and the opinions of the first and second committee are correct.

47. On question No.140, the model answer key lists option No.4 to be the correct answer. The first committee has opined the question to be ambiguous and thus be deleted. The second committee has concurred. Indeed, learned counsel agreed that the question has a syntax error and thus, the model key answer is wrong and that by the first and second committee to delete the question on account of it being ambiguous is correct. Meaning

thereby, the model answer key is wrong. Indeed, question needs to be deleted.

48. To put the data afore-noted in tabular form, the option which would be wrong or correct has been noted by us in the table under the head “Model Key, First Expert and Second Expert’ which reads as under:-

49. As it was concerning General Knowledge, the data pertaining to Geography also throws out a very interesting picture. Of the 13 questions, the model key gives only 4 correct options as the correct answers, 9 being wrong. The first and the second committee opined 9 to be the correct answers and 4 wrong answers but not unanimous on the said 9 and 4. As noted above, pertaining to question No.36 the first committee is correct and the second committee is wrong. Pertaining to question No.66, the first

committee is wrong and the second committee is correct. Pertaining to question No.70, the first committee is correct and the second committee is wrong. Pertaining to question Nos.72 and 97, the first committee is wrong and the second committee is correct. Similarly pertaining to question Nos.103 and 104, the first committee is correct and the second committee is wrong. Pertaining to question No.109, the first committee is wrong and the second committee is correct.

50. Now the learned Single Judge has held that since humans can never be perfect, there is no reason to go by the report of the second experts committee.

51. Pertaining to the analysis of the two sets of questions papers hereinabove, the position which emerges is that the matter needs a proper re-look. Indeed, in the latest decision pronounced in Richal's case(*supra*), the Supreme Court held the law to be that only demonstrably wrong answers need to be corrected and as we have noted hereinabove, demonstrably wrong answers are many in the model answer key and even the key provided by the first committee of experts and the second committee.

52. We have not carried out this exercise pertaining to all 18 question papers for the reason we find that pertaining to other 16 papers the similar variations in the opinions exist for as many upto 15 questions with the least being 2 in number in different papers.

53. We follow the path walked upon by the Supreme Court in Richal's case(*supra*) by directing a third committee to be constituted and since experts being nominated by the RPSC seem not to be upto the requisite standard, we direct the Vice Chancellor, University of Rajasthan at Jaipur to nominate three

Professors in each discipline to constitute the committee pertaining to each discipline and if three Professors in each discipline are not available, then to the extent of non-availability Associate Professors to be nominated. The questions which have become the subject matter of debate and have been indicated in Schedule-1 to the affidavit deposed on 11.05.2018 by the Assistant Secretary, RPSC, would be re-looked into by the said committee of experts constituted. The Secretary, R.P.S.C. would be the nodal officer to co-ordinate and ensure compliance.

54. The report would be produced in Court on the next date of hearing in D.B. Civil Special Appeal(W) No.1092/2015, which learned counsel state should be retained for final directions to be issued treating other writ-appeals to be disposed of.

55. Ordered accordingly.

56. Save and except D.B. Civil Special Appeal(W) No.1092/2015, all other writ-appeals are treated to have been disposed of observing that the final directions which would be in rem would follow once the report of the committee is placed before us.

57. D.B. Civil Special Appeal(W) No.1092/2015 be listed for directions on 23.07.2018.
