The petitioners are directed to implead the Madarsa in which they were employed, as a party in the writ petitions.

The case of the respondents in the course of hearing of this petition is that there has been humongous fraud in the appointment of Siksha Sahyogies and other employees in various Madarsas on contract basis. Appointments of Siksha Sahyogies and other employees in various Madarsas were made of those

whose applications were rejected and also of those who had not even applied for appointment to the posts in issue.

I am of the considered view that it is for the State Government to take proceedings under the criminal law and lodge a formal report before the ACB on account of fraud having taken place in appointment of Shiksha Sahyogies and other employees in various Madarsas to the detriment of public revenues.
