Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after remaining successful in all phases of the Sub-Inspector in Delhi Police, CAPFS and Assistant Sub-Inspector in CISF Examination, 2019, candidature of the petitioner has been rejected on account that he is suffering from Cubitus Valgus Deformity Right Elbow (carrying angle 20 degree) by the Medical Board and without specifying any carrying angle, by the review Medical Board whereas, as per the certificate issued by the SMS Medical College, his carrying angle is below 15 degree i.e. within the permissible limit of 20 degree as per the Clause-7 of the guidelines for Recruitment Medical Examination in Central Armed Police Forces and Assam Rifles issued by the Government of India through Ministry of Home Affairs (Police Division-II).

Issue notice of the writ petition as well as of stay application.

Rule is made returnable by five weeks. Notices be filed in two

sets. One set of notices be sent through registered post with acknowledgment due. Steps to be taken within a week.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner on interim relief.

Taking into consideration the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the material on record, this Court deems it just and proper to direct the respondents to keep a post vacant in pursuance of examination, 2019, till further orders.
