1. Heard on interim stay application.
2. The grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner was imposed punishment of censure and it is a minor penalty and this minor penalty shall not come in the way of depriving the petitioner for entitlement for consideration to the promotion on the ground of imposition of minor penalty. If the petitioner is deprived of consideration, the minor penalty itself become a major penalty by denying him promotion.
3. It is also his submission that the petitioner may be permitted to participate in the DPS, since he is a senior candidate and entitled for consideration but for the reason of the imposition

of minor penalty, the respondents are not calling the petitioner for consideration to the promotion post, therefore, he seeks interim protection.

4. Having considered the entirety of the case and submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court feels appropriate to direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to participate in the DPC, if he is otherwise eligible for consideration to the promotional post, however, he shall not be entitled for the promotion until the present writ petition is decided and the result shall be kept in sealed cover and the same shall be subject to final outcome of the present writ petition.
5. It is made clear that the respondents are entitled to fill-up the vacancies, for which, the candidates have participate, without waiting the result of the present writ petition, however, if the petitioner succeeds in the present writ petition, he shall be entitled for promotion by virtue of DPC and he shall be granted all the benefits from the date, on which, his Junior is promoted.
6. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in four weeks.
7. List the matter on 04.07.2026.
