1. Matter comes up on an application (IA No.1/2025) filed by the applicant/respondent under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking vacation of interim order dated 07.11.2024 passed by this Court.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant/respondent No.5 submits that the interim stay order is causing serious prejudice to the applicants; therefore, the same may kindly be vacated.
3. *Per contra*, learned counsel for the appellant submits that from the bare language of the interim order dated 07.11.2024, it is evident that it cannot be construed as causing any prejudice to the applicant/respondent No.5.
4. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the interim order dated 07.11.2024.
5. It would be apt to reproduce the interim order dated 07.11.2024 as under:-

"Issue notice to respondent No.2.

List after four weeks.

Meanwhile, operation and execution of the impugned judgment dated 21.09.2024 passed by the Additional District Judge No.11, Jaipur Metropolitan-Ist, Jaipur in Civil Suit No.319/2022 shall remain stayed."

6. From the bare reading of the order, it cannot be said that the interim order is causing any prejudice to the applicant/respondent No.5. Accordingly, the application (IA No.1/2025) filed by the applicant/respondent No.5, seeking vacation of the interim order dated 07.11.2024, is hereby dismissed.
7. The application (IA No.1/2025) stands disposed of.
8. List the matter on 12.03.2025.
