1. Petitioner has approached this Court with the grievance that her service may be counted, from the date when she was first appointed by the respondent-department, for the purpose of granting seniority and other consequential benefits.
2. Learned counsel submits that petitioner submitted a representation to the respondents in terms of the directions issued in the second round of litigation in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 11748/2017 decided vide order dated 21.07.2017, whereby she

was directed to submit a representation and the respondents were directed to consider the same and pass a reasoned order.

3. Learned counsel further submits that since the respondents did not consider the matter legally and passed a fresh impugned order dated 16.02.2021. Therefore, the petitioner has again approached this Court.

4. Heard learned counsels for the petitioner.

5. This Court noted that initially, the petitioner was offered appointment to the post of Nurse Grade-II vide office order dated 20.11.1998, however after joining, she did not report back and therefore, respondents cancelled her appointment, which she challenged by way of S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 5720/2005 which came to be dismissed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 18.05.2007. Against the aforesaid, petitioner filed the D.B. Civil Special Appeal (Writ) No. 772/2008 before the Division Bench which came to be allowed vide order dated 19.05.2011, wherein the Court directed the respondents to give fresh appointment to the petitioner from 30.06.2011. In compliance with the order of Division Bench of this Court, the respondents issued a fresh appointment order and the petitioner joined her duties on 04.07.2011.

6. Once the Division Bench of this Court directed for fresh appointment of petitioner from June, 2011, which respondents followed and she was given appointment in July, 2011, then the action of her filing a petition before the Court for the same grievance again is not genuine. Petitioner cannot be allowed to file the petition for the same grievance again and again which has already been examined and adjudicated by the Court.

7. This Court further noted that the impugned order 16.02.2021 passed by the respondent is strictly in compliance with the order dated 19.05.2011 passed by Division Bench of this Court. This Court, after considering the complete facts and circumstances, finds no merit in the present writ petition.

8. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is dismissed. No order as to costs.

9. All other pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
