Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR has been lodged on totally bogus and false allegations. The subject matter of the crime happens to be the prosecutrix Kumari Madhu who is a major girl aged about 20 years. The petitioner and the prosecutrix were having love relationship and they eloped because the family members of the parties were not agreeable for their marriage. It is submitted that marriage in between them got solemnized in a temple and thereafter registration of the marriage certificate has also been obtained by them. It is submitted that after registration of FIR, the prosecutrix of this case has made compromise which is annexed with the petition. It is categorically stated in the compromise deed that the prosecutrix does not wish to pursue the matter against the petitioner.

Mr. G.P. Rawat appearing on behalf of the complainant admits the fact of compromise and is agreeable for quashing of FIR.

Heard.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Mr. G.P. Rawat, counsel for the complainant accepts notice on behalf of complainant. Thus no need to issue notice.

Looking to the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, I deem appropriate to allow the criminal misc. application for stay of the proceedings.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner shall not be arrested until the final decision of the main petition.

Accordingly, the stay application is disposed of.

The main petition be listed after eight weeks.
