We have heard on the second stay application.

Learned senior counsel submits that while this Court, initially on 18.10.2024, directed that status quo with regard to the

possession of the property in dispute shall be maintained, it also observed that the matter requires arguments on behalf of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that the matter has been remanded and the Revenue Appellate Authority is proceeding with the case and if the proceedings before the Revenue Appellate Authority are allowed to continue, the very purpose of filing the present appeal would be frustrated.

We, therefore, restrain the Revenue Appellate Authority from deciding the case till disposal of the appeal.

Let the appeal itself be heard on merits on 15.07.2026.
