The instant contempt petition has been preferred against the respondents for non-compliance with the order dated 29.03.2023 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.10629/2021.

After perusing the order (Annexure-3), it is evident that the respondents were directed to convene the meeting of the PLPC and in pursuance to the directions, the meeting was held on 01.05.2024, which shows that on the aforesaid land, no encroachment was found. It was also found that on *Araji* Khasra

Nos. 320 and 165, a receiver was appointed and SHO Sikari took the possession of the land in pursuance to the appointment of receiver by the Court. In the minutes of the meeting, it is also stated that the matter is still pending before the concerned Court. Therefore, looking to the aforesaid facts, no case of contempt is made out.

Accordingly, the instant contempt petition is disposed of and rule is discharged.
