Mr. Ajay Shukla, learned counsel appears and accepts notice for respondent Nos.2 and 4. Mr. Sandeep Taneja, learned AAG appears and accepts notice for respondent No.3. Issue notice to respondent No.1- Rajasthan University on payment of process fee within a week, returnable within four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in this petition has already been entertained by this Court in the case of **KGN College of Pharmacy Vs. Rajasthan University of Health Sciences- D.B.Civil Writ Petition No. 6235/2024** wherein after issuing notices, an interim order has been passed in favour of the petitioner.



Per contra, learned counsel for the respective respondents would submit that after interim order was passed on 29.04.2024, a press release of the GST Council has been released on 09.09.2024 clarifying that affiliation services provided by Universities to their constituent colleges are not covered within the ambit of exemptions provided to the educational institution in the Notification dated 28.06.2017 and GST at the rate of 18% is applicable on the affiliation services provided by the Universities. It appears that when the interim order was passed, the aforesaid material was not before the Division Bench of this Court, therefore, this aspect would require consideration.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the respondents are granted short period of two weeks' to file reply in this matter.

The matter be listed in the first week of November, 2024 for consideration of stay application alongwith D.B.Civil Writ Petition Nos.14613/2024, 15100/2024, 15113/2024, 15622/2024 and 6235/2024.
