Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that giving criminal colour to a civil dispute, they have falsely been implicated in the subject FIR No.0272/2025 dated 31.07.2025 lodged by the respondent no.2/complainant with the allegations that despite receiving part sale consideration, the petitioners are not executing the sale deed in her favour.

Issue notice confined to the respondent no.2. Extra set be filed within two weeks failing which the criminal miscellaneous

petition shall stand dismissed without reference to the Court. Rule is made returnable by four weeks.

Learned Public Prosecutor shall procure the status report in the meanwhile.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners on interim relief.

Taking into consideration the contentions advanced by him and the material available on record, this Court deems it just and proper to stay arrest of the petitioners in the subject FIR, till further order.
