1. Matter comes up on an application (IA No.1/2024) filed by the appellants under Order 22 Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC), for taking the legal representatives of appellant No.2 - Om Prakash Nandwana S/o Mohan Lal, on record.
2. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the appellant No.2 - Om Prakash Nandwana S/o Mohan Lal, has expired on 10.11.2020. He further submits that initially, along with the said application, an application for condonation of delay was not filed and there was no prayer for setting aside the abatement. Therefore, the appellants have filed subsequent applications (IA Nos. 1/2026 and 2/2024) seeking condonation of delay in filing the application (IA No.1/2024) for taking the legal representatives of the appellant No.2 - Om Prakash Nandwana S/o Mohan Lal, on record, and setting aside the abatement against the deceased appellant No.2 - Om Prakash Nandwana S/o Mohan Lal.
3. Heard.

4. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the applications (IA Nos.1/2024, 2/2024 and 1/2026) are allowed, subject to the payment of cost of Rs.3,000/- to be paid in favour of *Secretary, Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority*, within a period of four weeks from today.
5. On deposit of the said costs of Rs. 3,000/-, the delay in filing the application (IA No.1/2024) is condoned and abatement, if any, shall stand set aside.
6. Amended cause title, annexed with the application, is taken on record, subject to deposition of the aforesaid cost.
7. Accordingly, the applications (IA Nos.1/2024, 2/2024 and 1/2026) stand disposed of.
8. List the matter after four weeks, as prayed.
