1. Mr. Tanveer Ahamad, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with the liberty to raise all his objections, both on law and facts, including with respect to the scope of Rule 35 of the Rajasthan Police Service Rules, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as '**the Rules of 1954**'), by filing a detailed reply to the impugned notices before the competent authority.

2. Considering the limited submission so made and without delving into the merits of the matter, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise all possible objections both on law and facts, including the one with respect to the scope of the Rule 35 of the Rules of 1954, before the competent authority, who would duly consider the same strictly in accordance with law.

3. Pending application(s), if any, stand dismissed.
