1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 08.07.2025 (Annexure-10) passed by Additional District Collector, Malpura, in Case No.17/2010 titled as Nrisingh Lal through LRs Vs. Satyanarayan and Another, vide which the order dated 10.12.2009 passed by Panchayat Samiti, Malpura, has been quashed and the matter has been remanded back for afresh consideration to Sub-Ordinate Sanstha

Administration and Standing Committee, Panchayat Samiti
Malpura.

- 2.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the genesis of the entire controversy is the *patta* dated 01.08.1983 (Annexure-2) issued by Gram Panchayat Diggi, Tehsil Malpura, in petitioner's favour, after which, the petitioner has rightly raised construction and is residing thereon since then.
- 3.** Learned counsel further submits that the respondent No.1 – complainant is the real brother of the petitioner and the complaint has been made for frivolous reasons.
- 4.** Learned counsel further submits that the impugned order dated 08.07.2025 remanding the matter, has been passed without considering the facts and evidences placed on record.
- 5.** Taking note of the above, issue notices to the respondents, returnable within four weeks. Notices may also be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.
- 6.** Notices also be given *dasti* to learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 7.** List the matter on 14.05.2026.
- 8.** Till the next date, the effect and operation of the order dated 08.07.2025 (Annexure-10) shall remain stayed.
