1. This suspension of sentence application has been filed by the applicant along with the appeal.
2. Counsel for the applicant has annexed the certificate under Rule 311 (3) of the Rajasthan High Court Rules to the effect that during the trial, the applicant was on bail and the sentence of life imprisonment has been awarded to the applicant under Section 302/34 of IPC and he is in judicial custody at Central Jail, Bharatpur. He further submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this matter and the hearing of appeal may take long

time and prayed that sentence awarded to the applicant may be suspended and he be released on bail during the pendency of the appeal.

3. Learned Deputy Government Advocate assisted by counsel for the complainant has opposed the suspension of sentence application and submitted that PW-1 who is daughter of the deceased in her statement recorded during trial has stated that the accused-applicant has pressed the throat on account of which deceased died. He has also referred the statement of doctor (PW-8).

4. We have heard counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case and also considering the statement of PW1 and PW-8 and looking to the seriousness of the offence(s) against the applicant, in our view, no case is made out for allowing this application for suspension of sentence.

6. Hence, this suspension of sentence application is dismissed.
