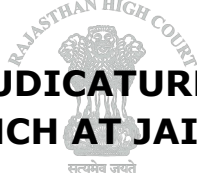

**Order**

1. This 2<sup>nd</sup> interim suspension of sentence application has been filed by the accused-applicant-Ramveer (for short 'the applicant') on the ground of marriage of his daughter which is scheduled to be held on 18.02.2025.
2. This Court vide order dated 11.02.2025 while disposing the earlier application for interim suspension directed the applicant to file an application for emergent parole before the authorities

concerned, who were directed to decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant filed an application before the authorities concerned for emergent parole for a period of 15 days' before Superintendent, Central Jail, Bharatpur vide order dated 12.02.2025 dismissed the said application filed by the applicant on the ground that emergent parole can be granted upto 7 days only. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that he is going to file an application for emergent parole for seven days' as per rules.

4. Taking into consideration overall facts and circumstances, we dispose of present second application for interim suspension of sentence with a direction that in case the applicant files an application for emergent parole for seven days', as per rules, before the authorities concerned, the concerned authorities shall decide the same preferably on the same day in accordance with law, taking into account that marriage of the applicant's daughter is scheduled to be held on 18.02.2025.
