Learned counsel for respondent No.1 accepts copy of memo of appeal.

Learned counsel for appellant submitted that the suit was filed in year 2009 and same was dismissed on application of respondent No.1 in September, 2023 but a confirm stay order was in force so he made a request for restraining alienation of the property till next date of hearing. He specifically referred order dated 06.07.2019 in CM No.101/2013 passed by learned Additional District Judge No. 19, Jaipur Metro, Headquarter Sanganer.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 opposed the application. He sought time to argue the matter.

A perusal of record indicated that on basis of application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC filed by the respondent No. 1 on 16.10.2021, civil suit was dismissed on 18.09.2023 by learned



Additional District Judge No. 10, Jaipur Metro-I, Headquarter Sanganer. During pendency of this suit, T.I. application was allowed on 06.07.2019 and parties were directed not to alienate the suit property till disposal of suit.

Considered aforesaid and heard submissions.

Respondent No.1 and other respondents are directed to follow and observe the stay order dated 06.07.2019 in CM No.101/2013 and the order shall remain in force till next date of hearing.
