Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that under
Section 67 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 (hereinafter

referred as 'the Act'), there is a statutory right to file an appeal against the order of National Commission. It is further submitted that objection raised qua the maintainability is not tenable for the reason that provisions of Section 67 of the Act are exercised when order is passed with respect to Section 58(1)(a) Sub Clause (1) & (2) of the Act and not otherwise.

Learned counsel has also submitted that appeals against the order of any State Commission order if passed by the National Commission, against the same remedy can be availed as a right before the Hon'ble High Court. In this regard, reliance is placed upon the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **(2024) 9 SCC 148** titled as **Universal Sampo General Insurance Co. Ltd. v. Suresh Chand Jain.**

Considering the fact that interim protection is granted in SBCWP No. 9488/2025, this Court directs that equivalent interim protection be made applicable qua the petitioners herein.
