Learned counsel for the appellants submit that the issue involved herein is no more res integra and stands resolved by a Co-ordinate Bench judgment of this Court dated 21.04.2026 in the case of **Union of India and Others vs. Gauri Shankar in D.B.**

Civil Writ Petition No. 18057/2025 and other connected matters in their favour and prays for disposal of the instant writ petition in terms thereof.

Although, learned counsel for the respondent does not dispute the aforesaid prayer but, he submits that in the Special Leave Petition (Civil) Diary No. 33265/2026 preferred thereagainst by the respondents in the writ petition, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has been pleased, vide its interim order dated 12.06.2026, to issue notice as also to permit the pensioners (petitioners) to avail the benefits under the Central Government Health Scheme till the next date. He, therefore, prays that his rights be made subject to the pending SLP.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the aforesaid prayer.

In view thereof, this writ petition is allowed in terms of judgment of a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court dated 21.04.2026 passed in the case of **Union of India** (supra). However, rights of the parties shall remain subject to decision of the pending SLP preferred thereagainst.
