1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with
following prayers:

"It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully
prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously
be pleased to accept and allow the present
Writ Petition and be further pleased to issue an
appropriate writ, order, or direction, thereby
directing the Respondents to consider and
appoint the Petitioner to the post of Deputy
Superintendent of Police under the provisions

of the Rajasthan Out of Turn Appointment to Sports Medal Winners Rules, 2017.

It is further prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to pass such order and further orders as may be deemed just, fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case, in the interest of justice, equity and good conscience in favour of the petitioner."

2. During course of arguments, learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner may be granted permission to file an appropriate representation before the respondents-Authority to consider and resolve her grievances.
3. Considered the grievance raised herein, the petitioner is given a liberty to submit a representation to the respondents-Authority within a period of 30 days raising all grounds and the respondents-Authority are directed to decide the representation with a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 30 days from date of receipt of representation. After the decision, the respondents are under an obligation to communicate the decision to the petitioner either by way of speed post or through E-mail, if petitioner has provided E-mail in his representation. If the petitioner is still aggrieved, she has a liberty to approach this Court with fresh petition.
4. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition with pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
