1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner, assailing the order dated 09.09.2025 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Bassi, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, whereby the appeal filed by the respondent was allowed against the order dated 09.05.2024 passed by the Gram Nyayalaya, Bassi, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, and consequently restrained the petitioner from temporary injunction.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Appellate Court has not taken into consideration that the original order was passed by the Gram Nyayalaya and as per Section 34 of the Gram Nyayalayas Act, 2008, an appeal under Section 34(3) is required to be filed within a period of 30 days from the date of the order of the Gram Nyayalaya. Whereas in the present case, the appeal has been filed after 90 days, without filing an application for condonation of delay.

3. In that view of the matter, Issue notice to the respondent, by both modes, ordinary as well as registered post, returnable within four weeks.
4. List the matter after four weeks.
5. Notice be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. Let record of the case relating to the temporary injunction application be summoned.
