1. After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ

petition and submits that the petitioner is willing to pay the requisite stamp duty payable on the agreement to sale dated 11.08.2003. It is further submitted that the liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before the learned Court below for payment of the deficient stamp duty on the said agreement.

2. In view of the aforesaid submissions, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application for payment of the necessary stamp duty.

3. However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner files such an application for payment of stamp duty on the document, the same shall be considered and decided by the concerned Court on its own merits and in accordance with law, without being influenced by this order.

4. The stay application as well as other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
