1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.526/2025 registered at Police Station Sadar Alwar District Alwar for offence under Section 111(2)(b), 112(2), 316(2), 318(4), 319(2) and 61(2) of BNS 2023 and Section 66D of Information Technology (Amended) Act, 2008.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that co-accused Mohammad Aspaq S/o Chand Khan was also granted benefit of bail by the trial Court itself on 17.10.2025. Learned counsel again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 13.10.2025. The trial of the case will take considerable time,

therefore, on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Irshad S/o Akbar** be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
