Mr. G.S. Gill, learned Additional Advocate General assisted by Mr. Manoj Kumar, Adv. appearing for the respondents submits that the order in regard to which the contempt petition has been preferred, is based on the judgment of the Board of Revenue. Learned Additional Advocate General further submits that against the judgment of the Board of Revenue, the State has already preferred S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.7707/2025 (The State of Raj. Vs. Ahnaf Ali) on 07.03.2025. He further submits that they may be allowed two weeks' time so that they may pursue their writ petition.

On an inquiry from the website of the Court, it is found that the State has filed the aforesaid writ petition on 07.03.2025, which is lying in defect. On 11.07.2025 on request of learned Additional Advocate General, two weeks' time was allowed to cure

the defect/s. The State has not cared to cure the defect/s, which shows that how sincere they are in pursuing their writ petition.

Taking note of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and the gentle request made by learned Additional Advocate General, this contempt petition is adjourned for 25.09.2025.

If the respondents do not comply with the order of the Court dated 14.11.2018 by the next date of hearing, the present District Collector, Kota and the present Tehsildar, Tehsil Ladpura, District Kota, shall remain personally present before this Court on 25.09.2025.
