Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 21.06.2019 passed by the Court of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Khetri, District Jhunjhunu by which cognizance was taken against the accused-respondents Umrao Singh and Yogendra Meena under Sections 448, 427 & 120B IPC and the

same was assailed by them by way of S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No. 4122/2019, but the same was not pressed, hence, the said petition was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 03.07.2019.

2. This fact has been disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents Umrao Singh. He submits that the cognizance order was never assailed by the respondent before this Court rather the S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No. 4122/2019 was submitted before this Court for quashing the proceedings of the impugned FIR No. 139/2017.
