It has been apprised at Bar by learned counsel for the petitioner-Gyanwati that cognizance has been taken against the accused by the Court of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khetri, Jhunjhunu vide order dated 21.06.2019 and the same was assailed by the accused persons before this Court by way of filing S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition No.4122/2019 and the same was withdrawn by them on 03.07.2019 and again the same order was assailed by the same accused persons before the Revisional Court by way of filing the criminal revision petition, which was partly allowed and partly rejected vide order dated 03.08.2019.
2. Aggrieved by the aforesaid, both the complainant as well as the accused have approached this Court by way of filing three different petitions.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once the earlier petition i.e. S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition No.4122/2019 was withdrawn by the accused persons on 03.07.2019 without seeking any permission to file criminal revision petition before the Revisional Court, then under these circumstances, a revision petition cannot be submitted against the order of cognizance dated 21.06.2019. Learned counsel submits that such an act of the accused persons amounts to gross abuse of the process of law.

4. Before passing appropriate orders, learned counsel for the parties are directed to apprise this Court that on which day the criminal revision petition was submitted by the accused persons before the Revisional Court assailing the order of cognizance dated 21.06.2019.
