Learned counsel for the respondent submits that vide order dated 03.06.2025, as per the directions of the Court, the petitioner was granted regularization of his services on notional basis w.e.f. 12.10.1992 and also the amount including all consequential benefits, gratuity computation and PL encasement.

It is also stated that vide Office order dated 20.11.2025, the sanctioned order granting 300 days of PL as per Rule 91-B of the Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951 has already been passed, therefore, the contempt petition may be dismissed.

Contrarily, it is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that other similarly placed petitioners were granted benefit of regularization by giving actual benefits, however, the same has not been granted to the petitioner.

It is also contended that though vide order dated 20.11.2025 sanction for granting 300 days PL amount has been ordered, however, the same amount has yet not been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to file specific affidavit with regard to payment of unpaid amount.

Meanwhile, learned counsel for the respondent is also directed to ensure that in pursuance to the order dated 20.11.2025, whether the petitioner have been paid the amount of 300 days sanctioned PL and so also the gratuity amount.

List the matter after two weeks.
