Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are members of Scheduled Tribes Category and are Forest Dwellers, having possession and occupation of the forest land from the last so many decades.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the claim petitions under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 as well as Rules made thereunder have already been filed by the respective petitioners and the same have been forwarded but no final decision upon the same have been taken by competent Authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that on one hand the claim petitions have not been decided, however, the respondents have forcefully demolished the residential houses of the petitioners and now trying to dispossess the petitioners from their respective agricultural land.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of

Petition(s) (Civil) No(s).109/2008.***

Matter Requires Consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply two sets of writ petitions in the office of Mr. B.S. Chhaba, AAG who appears for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and Mr. G.S. Gill, AAG who appears for respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Hence, service upon all the respondents is treated as complete.

Mr. B.S. Chhaba, AAG and Mr. G.S. Gill, AAG are directed to complete their instructions and file their reply by the next date regarding the status of the claim petitions filed on behalf of the petitioners and apprise the same to this Court.

In view of the submissions so made, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners.
